

PAPER PRODUCTS / CORUGATED CARDBOARD

Newspapers, magazines, boxboard, and junk mail. Keep clean and dry.

GLASS (CLEAR, GREEN, AND BROWN)

All glass is to be rinsed thoroughly.

*Windows, window glass, and doors are **NOT** recyclable – see attendant for these items.*

PLASTIC / TIN CANS

Plastic containers with the number 0-7 stamped on the bottom are acceptable for recycling.

Both plastic and tin containers must be rinsed thoroughly. *Plastic bags are **NOT** recyclable.*

PAPER PRODUCTS, CORRUGATED CARDBOARD, GLASS, PLASTIC AND TIN CANS ARE ALL RECYCLEABLE AND SHOULD BE PLACED IN THE RECYCLABLE COMPACTOR

No separation is required for items placed into the recyclable compactor.

METALS / BRUSH / FOILAGE

All metals and brush are accepted.

Leaves, pine needles, grass clippings, and garden waste are accepted, but must be kept separate from the brush.

All leaves, pine needles, grass clippings, and garden waste must be taken out of any bags/containers and placed in the compost pile.

Stumps up to 2 feet in diameter are accepted.

BATTERIES (AUTO AND CYCLE)

Both types of batteries are accepted inside of the building.

ELECTRONICS

See attendant.

USED OIL

See attendant.

NOT ACCEPTED:

Refrigerators, fluorescent bulbs, tires, lumber, demolition debris.
