Rockin' in the Great South Woods

Options for Contributing

Now in its 8th year, the Sunday Rock Legacy Project (SRLP) continues to bring together three organizations—Colton Historical Society, Colton-Pierrepont Central School (CPCS), and Grasse River Players—to pursue projects of historical, educational, and theatrical interest.

The 2019 theme—Rockin' in the Great South Woods—provides the basis for activities underway including historical research about people, places, and happenings in the southern part of town past Sunday Rock and the hamlet of South Colton. The wild forested lands that lay south of the St. Lawrence Valley, known as the Great South Woods, and an old dilapidated tavern along Route 56 near Sevey's Corners, known as the Windfall House, provide the backdrop and setting for this year's theatrical foray. *The Tavern*, a melodrama spoof by George M. Cohan, will be presented with music of the era on July 18, 19, and 21 (before & after traditional Colton Country Day activities). Throughout the summer there will be an exhibit on related topics in the Colton Museum; and CPCS students will participate in various activities.

Activities are made possible in part with funds from the Decentralization Program, a regrant program of the New York State Council on the Arts with the support of Governor Andrew M. Cuomo and the New York State Legislature, as administered by the St. Lawrence County Arts Council.
