AUGUST COLTON REPORTS

The Transfer Station is well on its way. As of this month we are \$50,000 below budget. Thanks to the Highway Dept. Superintendent Kevin Hawley has saved us thousands of dollar in fill, sand and gravel. Thank you for working with DPW, it has been good teamwork . Both departments have done well.

We took down 3 or 4 trees at Sunday Rock. They were in bad and unsafe condition. Thanks to Chris Shea and his crew for a super job as he always does. We will be transplanting new maple trees to replace the ones we took down.

We are in progress of starting to replace sidewalks in stages. The first stage is from SH 56 to the stone wall at Community Church. The second stage goes from the stone wall to the intersection by Hilltop and McKabe Rd. I would like to see sidewalks completely replaced in both Colton and South Colton within a three year time frame.

The sewer plant has a \$400,000 grant to repair and replace operating parts. This first repair involves draining the sewer tank at 10:00 p.m. August 22,2023. The work will take most of the night and by morning will be up and running again. One more job done.

At this time I like to recognize Darren Richards and Jeff Tubilino and the grant work they have done to obtain thousands of dollars for the Town. Without these grants we could not have done all we have.

I would ask all the good citizens to go around the Town and check out what your Town government has done for you the last 6 years. I am proud of what we have done. It's all been done through teamwork.
