Size – 4x4 foot barn quilt on MDO plywood (1/2 inch thick)

<u>Schoolhouse quilt block</u> – traditional block design to tie in with early schoolhouse project and fact that Museum was used as a school after the Colton Union Free School burned

<u>Colors</u> – red (indicative of 'little red schoolhouse' as once existed in Colton) plus blue to reflect sky and dark gray / black to stand out from gray siding of Museum

<u>Designers</u> – Town of Colton Tourism & Beautification Committee in conjunction with Colton Historical Society

Painters - CPCS Art Club / Students (5th and 6th grades)

<u>Timeframe</u> – fall / winter 2014 to be done by kick-off of Winterfest
