## Fourth Annual Remembrance Tree Project

In conjunction with the Colton Historical Society's  
2017 Winter Lights & Jingle Bells Event and Reception  
and the Town's 2018 Winterfest Weekend

**Remembrance Trees** are a great way for residents and others to celebrate the upcoming holidays and brighten the winter nights. You can order a tree measuring about 5 feet tall to honor your family, remember a loved one or special event, or just add sparkle and warmth during the holidays and winter season. After Thanksgiving the Town of Colton's Tourism & Beautification Committee will set up ordered Remembrance Trees in the hamlets of Colton and South Colton. In Colton they will be along Main Street, split between the Museum lawn next to the Zion Episcopal Church and the Green between the Library and Town Hall. And in South Colton they will be in Three Falls Park at the corner of State Highway 56 and Sugar Bush Lane. Starting at 6pm the trees will be lit the evening of Friday, December 8 during the Winter Lights & Jingle Bells event being organized by the Colton Historical Society. This year, following the lightings in South Colton and Colton, a reception will follow in the Town Hall during which the names of those honored will be read while refreshments are served.

**Cost to participate is \$35.00**—includes cost of the tree plus set up and power cord run to the location of the tree. The Tourism & Beautification Committee will identify each tree with a laminated tag naming those remembered and the sponsor(s). Any lighting added by sponsors must be LEDs in whatever color(s) desired. Non-electrical decorations, garland, tinsel, and non-glass ornaments also are allowed. Trees will be left up and lighted through Winterfest Weekend on January 25-28, 2018. Lights and decorations left on trees by the weekend following Winterfest will be discarded or become the property of the Tourism & Beautification Committee.
